SUPER PASS: The Super Pass gets you in to all preliminary indoor sporting events on a first come, first served basis - up to 789 events! Seating is not guaranteed, but 10 minutes after a game begins, Super Pass holders can sit in any unoccupied reserved seat. Admission: \$30 Adult, \$25 Children/Seniors. **Opening and Closing Ceremonies, Cultural Galas and Gold Medal Hockey games require a separate ticket and are not covered by the Super Pass.*

DAY PASS: The Day Pass gives you access to all preliminary round sport events and medal rounds (except Gold Medal Hockey) for one day only. Day Passes will be available for purchase at Games time. Admission: \$15 Adult, \$10 Children/Seniors

OPENING CEREMONY: Sunday, March 4, 2012, Canada Games Centre, 6:00pm (doors open at 5:00pm). Admission: \$40 Adult, \$35 Children/Seniors. **Guaranteed admission/no assigned seating.*

CLOSING CEREMONY: Saturday, March 10, 2012, Canada Games Centre, 6:00pm (doors open at 5:00pm). Admission: \$40 Adult, \$35 Children/Seniors. **Guaranteed admission/no assigned seating.*

GOLD MEDAL HOCKEY: Midget Male/Bantam Male/Junior Female. Friday & Saturday, March 9 & 10, 2012, Takhini Arena. Admission: \$15 Adult, \$10 Children/Seniors. **Guaranteed admission/no assigned seating.*
